4. FIA AND OTHER TITLES ELIGIBILITY

4.1. FIA titles for which the Event counts

FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup with the following titles:

- FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup – Driving Test events for Drivers of vehicles in Article 2 in the Technical Regulations.
- FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup – Driving Test events for Co-Drivers of vehicles in Article 2 in the Technical Regulations.
- FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup for Manufacturers of vehicles in Article 2 in the Technical Regulations.

4.2. Other titles

5. VEHICLES ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE

All vehicles must be in conformity with the Technical Regulations of the FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup.

6. GENERAL CONDITIONS

6.1. The event will be organized in conformity with:

- the FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices;
- the Sporting Regulations of the FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup;
- the applicable prescriptions stated in the National Sporting Regulations; and

- the present Supplementary Regulations.

The Organizing Committee will ensure that the event complies with all the rules and regulations stated above, and that the event has received all the required administrative authorizations.

6.2 Insurance

The organiser has contracted insurance covering the following risks:

Civil liability insurance amounting to PLN 50000, extended by clause No.16 (The insurance policy will be presented at the Official Notice Board) – Extension of insurance scope to claims referring to damages having occurred during the time of insurance to participants of a non-mass event subjected to mandatory civil liability insurance.

7. ITINERARY AND LAYOUT

In the present paragraph, the Organizer must present the basic data of the planning of the event, providing all the vital information regarding the various parts of the event such as: 1 RPNE rally route covers a total of 715,4 km including 11 Regularity Tests (covering 285,06km). Rally is divided into 7 legs.

Organizer does not allow route reconnaissance.

Organizer set up a trip meter calibration stage. Itinerary for the calibration section will be issued during the Administrative Check.

Itinerary for the rally will be issued in the Rally Office on August 29, 2018 from 15.15.

Start

The starting interval between the cars is 1 minute. The start is in accordance with the Starting List.

Crews must have their passage checked at all points mentioned on their time card in the correct order.

Controls – General Provisions

All controls, i.e. passage and time controls, start and the end of regularity tests («RT») are indicated by means of FIA approved standardized signs (see also Appendix 1). Intermediate time checks on the regularity test sections are not indicated

Crews are obliged to follow the instructions of the marshals in charge of any control post.

All marshals at the posts are dressed in yellow or green high visibility vests.

If the route of the rally at some point proves to be impassable, event participants are required to make a detour and return to the rally route by the shortest way.

Passage and Time Controls (PC, TC)

Passage Controls – PC

At these controls, the post marshals simply stamps and/or signs the time card as soon as this is handed in by the crew, without mentioning the time of passage.

Time Controls – TC

At these controls, the post marshal enters the time at which one of the crew members hands the time card to the post marshal. The check-in time is the time obtained by adding the time allowed to complete the road section to the time of leaving the time control of the previous section.

Any difference between the actual check-in time and the target check-in time is penalized as follows :

- For late arrival – 1 min or fraction of a minute = 10 points.
- For early arrival – 1 min or fraction of a minute = 60 points

Maximum permitted delay with regard to target time for presentation to time controls is 30 minutes.

Organizer allows for early arrival at TC: 2E, 4E, 6E, 8E, 10E, 12E, 14E, 16E, 19E, 22E, 24E.

Failure to complete one or more legs of same day:

A crew who, for technical reasons, has missed during a leg a time control or a passage control may be re-admitted to the rally for the next day by submitting a written request to the Clerk of the Course.

The procedure followed is described in details in to article 7.1 of Sporting Regulation

In order to be classified, the car must report to the final Time Control post.

Regrouping Controls

Regrouping Controls may be set up at any point along the route. On their arrival at these regrouping controls, the crews hand the post marshal their time card. They receive instructions as to their restart time.

Regularity Test Sections (RT)

Regularity Tests Sections are organized on public roads open for public traffic.

Regularity Test Sections are marked like Super Stages according to FIA regulations.

Regularity Test Sections need to be passed through at an average speed set by the Organizer, different for each Regularity Test.

The Organizer might introduce changes to the initially set average speed at any point of an RT. Places of the average speed changes would be marked in the itinerary as „beginning

of speed change” and „end of speed change”, indicating thereby new average speed required from the Participants. After having passed the „end of speed change” mark, the valid average speed is as set at the start of a given RT.

On track of every RT, the Organizer is allowed to place undisclosed number checkpoints where Crews’ performance is measured with the use of chronometer or GPS. Accuracy of such reads is 1/10 of a second.

Every Crew shall receive average speed limits for RTs at the Administrative Checks .

RT penalties::

- Time below or above the target time at every checkpoint: 1 second = 10 point;
- Failing to complete an RT – 3000 points;
- Missing an RT checkpoint – 500 points;
- Maximum amount of points available per RT – 3000 points.

8. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

8.1. Nature of the event

The 1 Rally Poland New Energies is an E-Rally Regularity event. Each competitor will collect penalty points at the “Regularity Stages” and at the road connecting the sections (Time Control penalties) in accordance with the present Supplementary Regulations and the Bulletins, which may be issued at a later stage.

8.2. Start, Finish, Results

8.2.1. The start signal for the event will be given on Kraków, Main Market 29.08.2018 (Wednesday).

The first car will start at 18:00.

During the overnight stays and after the finish of the rally the cars will remain in the Parc Fermé, in which they will enter as soon as they finish a leg.

The starting sequence will follow the participation number and the cars will start at one-minute intervals.

9. CHARGING (BEV/PHEV)

The organising committee will supply electric power for recharging:

- Recharging points: Wieliczka ul Krakowska 14c Hotel Soray GPS:N 49 59' 43" – E 20 2'3"
- Voltage / Amperage supplied: 230V/16A
- Type of sockets: 1: Typ Schucko typ F; 2: typ Camper Standard CEE



NOTE: The number of sockets in every recharging point as well as the energy supplied must be sufficient to connect all entry vehicles simultaneously, plus 10% in case of malfunction of any of the sockets.

10. ENERGY CONSUMPTION INDEX CLASSIFICATION (OPTIONAL)

See Article 14 of the Sporting Regulations of the FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup.

11. ENTRY PROCEDURE AND FEES

The amount of the entry fee is fixed for each crew comprising two people (driver and co-driver, or driver and navigator):

- a) With the optional advertising proposed by the Organiser: 700 EUR
- b) Without the optional advertising proposed by the Organiser: 1400 EUR

This entry fee includes:

- ✓ Full documentation of the Rally, including competition numbers and two rally plates (one of which is a souvenir);
- ✓ Guarded parking place for the car participating in the Rally + one service car + one trailer;
- ✓ 4-night stay in a 2-person hotel room, breakfast included, between 29.08.2018 and 2.09.2018;
- ✓ Supper – buffet on 29.08.2018 and 30.08.2018;
- ✓ Meals during the Rally – (3 suppers and 4 snacks) on 30.08.2018, 31.08.2018 and 1.09.2018
- ✓ Participation in the official Commander's Ball on 1.09.2018.

The participant must bear the cost of bank transfers.

The Organizer will provide the participants with material and services as referred to in Art. 11 in the Sporting Regulations of the FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup.

11.1 Refund Entry Fee

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- If the entry is not accepted.
- If the event is cancelled.

The organizer can return up to 50% of the entry fee to those participants who submit a written withdrawal until 6.08.2018.

11.2 Crew documents

A crew comprises one driver and one co-driver, or one driver and one navigator.

Both must be a holder of the following documents:

- ✓ Driving licence according to the entered vehicles (not applicable for the navigators only)
- ✓ Any grade of FIA licence, issued by their ASN, or
- ✓ An FIA licence, grade D (or equivalent), obtained for the event, and valid for its duration, which has been issued by their ASN or by the organizer's ASN (with the written permission of the competitor's ASN) and handed over to the participants at the latest during the administrative checks. It will be subject to the payment of a fee of 50 EUR.
- ✓ Vehicle document permitting its free circulation on public roads.
- ✓ Should it be applicable, a vehicle document required in the Technical Regulations of the FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup.
- ✓ Vehicle valid insurance certificate in accordance with the traffic Code.

11.3. Entry Form

Any person, or legal entity, wishing to participate to the event must submit to the Event secretariat, a properly filled-in and signed entry form (see Appendix 1), together with all other requested documents, photos, etc. before 06.08.2018, 23:59

11.4. The field for participation is unlimited.

11.5. The minimum number of entered cars is: 5 cars. (It means the number of cars below of which the event it will be cancelled)

12. Advertising Promotion and Publicity

12.1. Official Supporter

The organisation of the event is supported by TBA, the logos of which must, as a matter of obligation, be displayed on the competition numbers and on any other promotional material intended to be placed on vehicles. Optional advertising material can be proposed by the organisers as follows:

- Meals during the Rally – (3 suppers and 4 snacks) on 30.08.2018, 31.08.2018 and 1.09.2018
- Participation in the official Commander's Ball on 1.09.2018.

13. GENERAL CLASSIFICATION, FIA E-RALLY REGULARITY CUP POINTS, OTHER CLASSIFICATIONS – AWARDS

13.1. FIA Classifications

The following classifications will be submitted to the FIA for the allocation of FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup points:

- Regularity Tests
- Road Penalties
- Final Classification – Drivers, Co-Drivers, and Manufactures.

The classification statements must contain the name and the date of the event; the first name, surname and nationality of Competitors, Drivers and Co-Drivers; the Vehicle Manufacturer as should be listed in the Manufacturers' Cup classification; and the Road penalty points, the Regularity Stages penalty points and the sum of penalty points.

13.2. Other Classifications (if any)

13.3 Cups / Trophies

For final Classifications as stated in Art. 13.1 above, [Cups](#) will be awarded to the [three](#) first placed competitors (Driver and Co-Driver). The Cups are of free design but should reflect the importance of the Event. They will be provided by the Organizer and must show:

- a) The FIA E-Rally Regularity Cup official logo.
- b) The official name of the event and/or the title sponsor's logo.
- c) The driver's position.

The organizer is free to include special trophies

14. PROTESTS / APPEALS

The amount of the protest fee is [250 EUR](#).

Protests against the preliminary official results of the Event must be lodged, in writing, in accordance with the prescriptions set in the ISC with the Clerk of the Course within 30 minutes of the moment of their posting on the official notice board. Upon the expiration of this time period, the preliminary results become final.

Every protest is eligible to be examined by the Stewards of the Event only if it is accompanied by the aforementioned protest fee defined in this article, which is not refundable should the protest fail to be upheld.
